- I. Introduction – Space updates
 - a. Gold Bond Building
 - i. Family Medicine 8th flr and 2nd flr Pacific Disabilities Center have moved to JABSOM MEB
 - ii. 10th (Native Hawaiian health), 6th (communication science disorders), and 3rd floor (psychiatry research) are currently subleased from UCERA
 1. 3rd floor will not be retained after 2019
 - b. JABSOM
 - i. Pathology will be moving to the 2nd floor Eva/Mauka side
 - ii. Department of Complimentary and Integrative Health/Biostatistics (John Chen's group) will be moving to 4th floor (pathology side) around May

 - i. BSB 101 Lab – World renown forensic expert, Bob Mann, is now volunteer faculty here at JABSOM, he is helping to develop a forensic program
 - ii. This includes creating skeletonization of donor bodies, this work is significant since there is no collection of skeletons from South Pacific populations
 - iii. Another goal is to develop a certification program
 - iv. Suggestion to move the lab to 119, it is a larger space for growth
