

JABSOM Surfboard Rack Use

The John A. Burns School of Medicine surfboard racks are installed along the wall inside the mail room located in Ancillary Building 103.

The use of the surfboard racks is for students and employees of the John A. Burns School of Medicine while at work or taking classes. The racks shall not be used as overnight storage.

The racks are available for use on a first come, first served basis. The racks accommodate padlocks to secure the surfboards stored on the racks. Users must provide their own locks. If a board is deemed abandoned, locks will be cut and abandoned surfboards will be disposed.

The John A. Burns School of Medicine shall not be responsible for any damage or loss of surfboards stored on the racks.

Access to the area is available:

Weekdays, 5:00 am - 10:00 pm.

After 4:00 pm on weekdays a valid JABSOM Access Card is required to enter the area. No access is allowed on weekdays observed as a holiday.

Please note that the light switch for the room is located on the left of the door as you enter. Please turn out the lights when leaving the area before 7:00am and after 4:00pm.

Be aware of your surroundings when in this area especially during the dark hours of the day.
