

## FAQs for the Needs-Based Scholarships for the *Medical Diagnosis and Treatment Program*

### Who is eligible to apply for a scholarship?

Students in grades 10-12 who have legal residence in Hawaii during the 2023-2024 academic year.

### What does the scholarship cover?

The scholarship covers the program registration fee. Participants are responsible for any other costs associated with attending the program, e.g. meals, travel, and lodging.

### How many scholarships are available?

### What is the deadline to apply for a scholarship?

The completed scholarship application form, including the personal statement, **must be received by 4:30 p.m., April 12, 2024**. We will email you a confirmation once we have received it.
